Primrose at the Princess
In partnership with NHS Worcestershire



Primrose at the Princess is an in-patient palliative unit located at the Princess of Wales Community Hospital, Bromsgrove. It provides specialised care to patients with cancer and other life limiting illness.

Made possible through a partnership with NHS Worcestershire, the unit is an integral part of the services offered by Primrose Hospice.

By becoming a Sharer of Care, you can help us to meet our commitment to the people of Worcestershire by funding care of a patient occupying one bedroom for one day each year.



How the unit helps patients

Primrose at the Princess provides short periods of care at times of particular need, improving the quality of life for patients with advanced disease, and supporting their families. More than 50% of patients return home following their stay in this kind of facility, with the average length of stay being 10-14 days.

Admission to the palliative care unit can help with the following:

- Pain control
- Symptom management
- Rehabilitation
- Terminal care
- Reassessment of needs to resolve a crisis

The specially designed accommodation includes:

- Six individual bedrooms with en-suite facilities
- Day room
- Visitors' room - with overnight accommodation if required
- An enclosed garden area

How you can help

By making a monthly donation you can become a sharer of care. To care for each patient each day of the year at the Primrose at the Princess it costs approximately £300.00 (this is in addition to funding our Day Hospice, Primrose Hospice Centre of Care.)

By donating £10.00 per month by standing order, you can become a sharer of care and help us meet the costs of this vital service.

When you receive your application, we will send you an acknowledgement. Then you can expect:
